

John Franklin, Mayor of Vista, is running for San Diego County Board of Supervisors District 5 in 2026 to fill the seat of termed out Supervisor, Jim Desmond.

JOHN FRANKLIN

Mayor of Vista, John Franklin, has a long history of public service beginning after college working as a policy advisor for two members of the US House of Representatives. His local tenure started in 2012 when he was first publicly elected to serve on the Vista Irrigation District Board of Directors. His popularity with both Vista citizens and fellow public servants increased and lead him to being elected to City Council in 2014 and to Deputy Mayor by majority vote of the City Council in 2017, 2019 and 2022.

Mr. Franklin has served the greater North County area in leadership roles including SANDAG, North County Emergency Dispatch JPA, Encina Wastewater Authority, and North County Transit District.

In 2022, he was elected Mayor of Vista on a platform focusing on solutions to homelessness and improved public safety. He is a strong believer in fiscally responsible and transparent government, and an advocate for improving traffic flows, eliminating blight, improving parks and acquiring new public park lands, and promoting art in the community. In support of Vista's long-term efforts to revitalize the downtown and Santa Fe corridor, he works to create a business-friendly climate to attract new investments and employers the City.

He and his wife, Shanna, own a small business in Vista.
