

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Democrats are working with labor union bosses to put a repeal of Prop 13 on the ballot in 2026. The bill – passed in 1978, promised to set property tax rates at the state level and cap increases at 1% of the value per year, with re-assessments coming only upon sale or significant renovation. Taxes can only go up a maximum of 2% per year. This essentially transformed the property tax system in California from a market-based system to an acquisition-based one. An overwhelming majority of Californian voters - almost 66% voted for Prop 13 because they knew that the initiative would finally take power away from the tax collectors and give it back to the taxpayers The passage of Prop 13, allowed neighborhoods to stay intact and kept elderly residents on fixedincomes in their homes rather than being forced out by increasingly high tax bills. Despite what many politicians say, total property tax revenues to local governments in California have increased at a rate exceeding inflation and virtually all other economic indicators.

Proposition 13 protects homeowners and all taxpayers by requiring a two-third vote to pass certain tax increases, including the state sales and income tax. The intention of the supermajority requirement is to have a system whereby taxes cannot be raised too easily, or too often.

Efforts to hobble-if not destroy Prop 13 come with nearly every election cycle in California. Democrats continued next page
