SHAUN FREDRICKSON

Shaun Frederickson is a devoted family man residing in North County San Diego. Fourteen years ago, during a year-long missions trip around the world, he met his wife, and together they now have four children. Shaun is deeply committed to empowering Christians and living out his faith in San Diego, California.

In July 2021, Shaun captured the attention of the nation with a powerful 60-second speech confronting San Diego County Health Director Wilma Wooten. The speech, which went viral garnering over 12 million views, ignited a movement of Southern California residents opposing lockdowns and unjust mandates.

As a leader of this movement, Shaun founded the Freedom Revival, organizing two major events that drew 12,000+ attendees each. His vision is to see a robust church actively engaged in politics, striving to restore the American republic. Shaun has collaborated with notable organizations such as PragerU, TPUSA Faith, and the First Liberty Institute.

Andrew Hayes is a lifelong resident of East County. He's running for CA State Assembly against Carl DeMaio to fill Marie Waldren's seat in the November elections. He was a legislative aide to Senator Joel Anderson and has had great success leading the Lakeside Union School District Board of Trustees. Andrew has been on the frontlines fighting for conservative principles to help defeat Democrats' reckless spending and far-left agenda and plans to continue that fight against Gavin Newsom.



You may have a property that requires the Trespass Arrest Authorization form to be notarized & submitted to allow the SD Sheriff to actually arrest trespassers upon your request. As of Jan. 1, 2024 when SB 602 went into effect, an arrest is not automatic without this form. Click the link for the San Diego County form and instructions. Consider doing this now instead of waiting until you need help.
